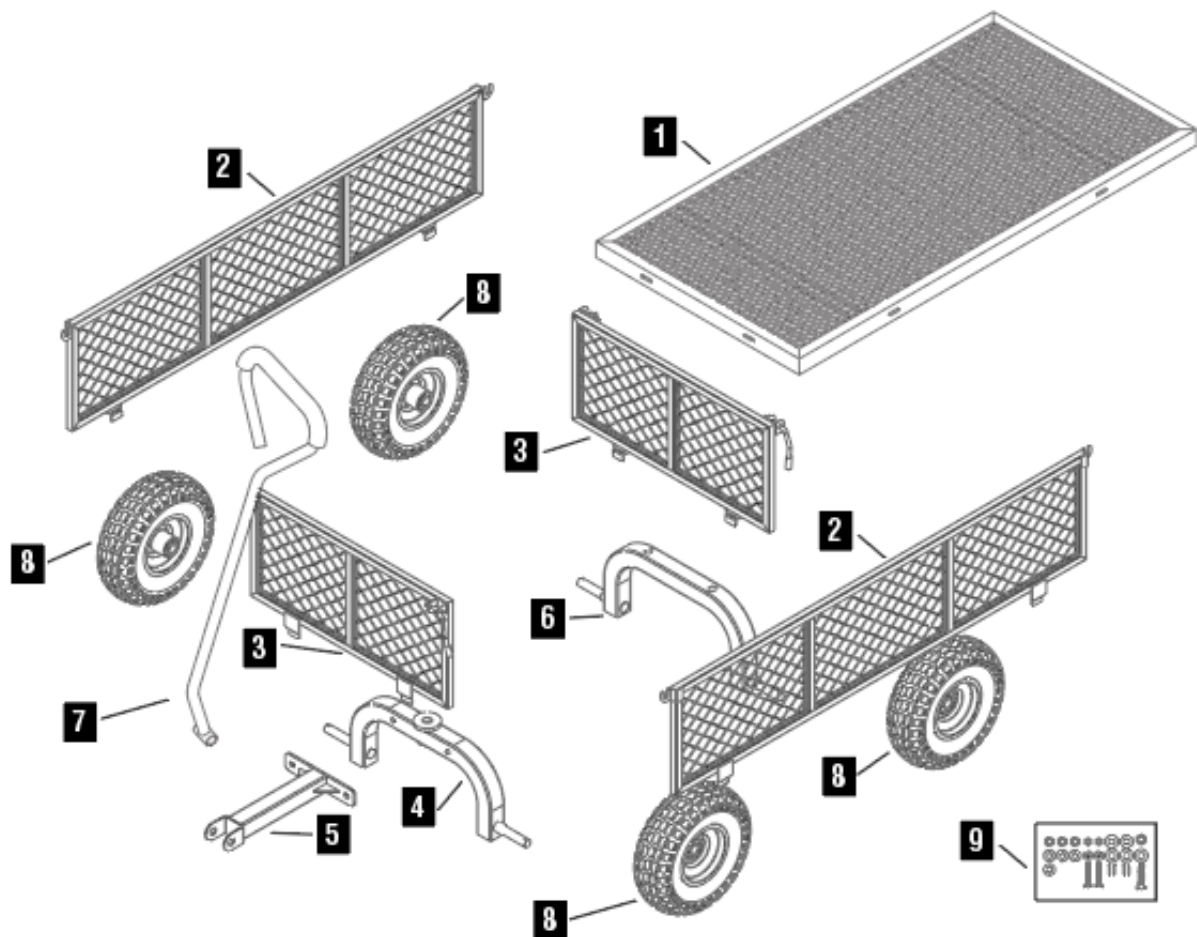

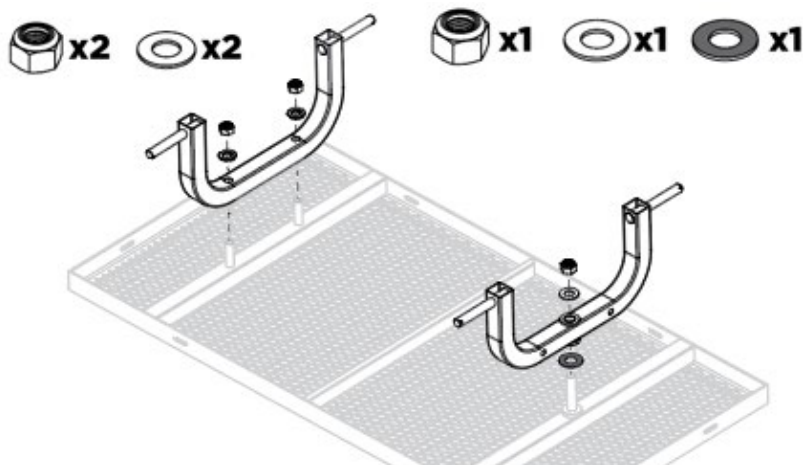
Recommended Tools

Screwdriver, needle-nosed pliers, and adjustable wrenches



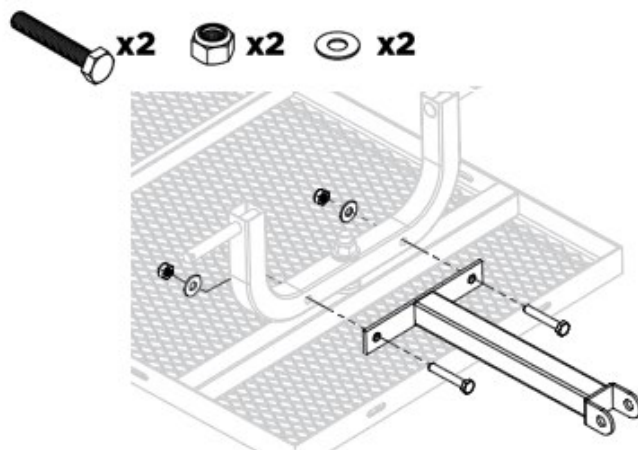
STEP 1

Assemble the front axle and rear axles to the bed of the cart. Tighten all bolts securely.



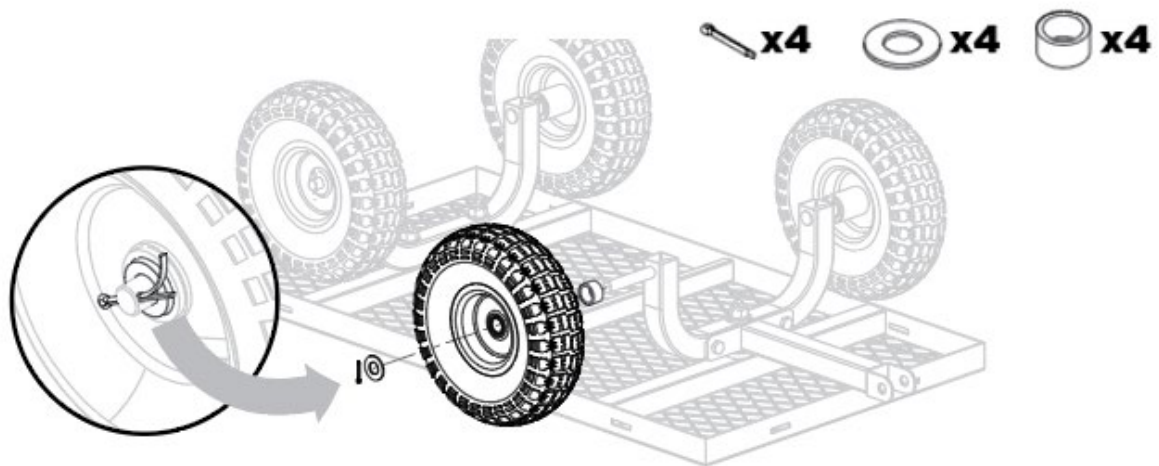
STEP 2

Assemble the yoke to the front axle. Tighten all bolts securely.



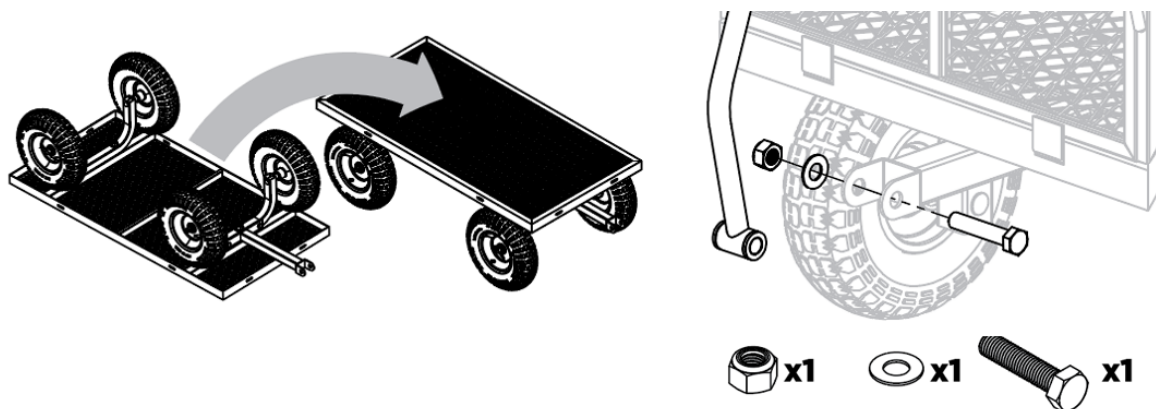
STEP 3

Place the wheel spacer onto each axle, then the wheels (valve stem facing out) and secure using washers and cotter pins. Bend back the ends of the cotter pins to keep them in place.



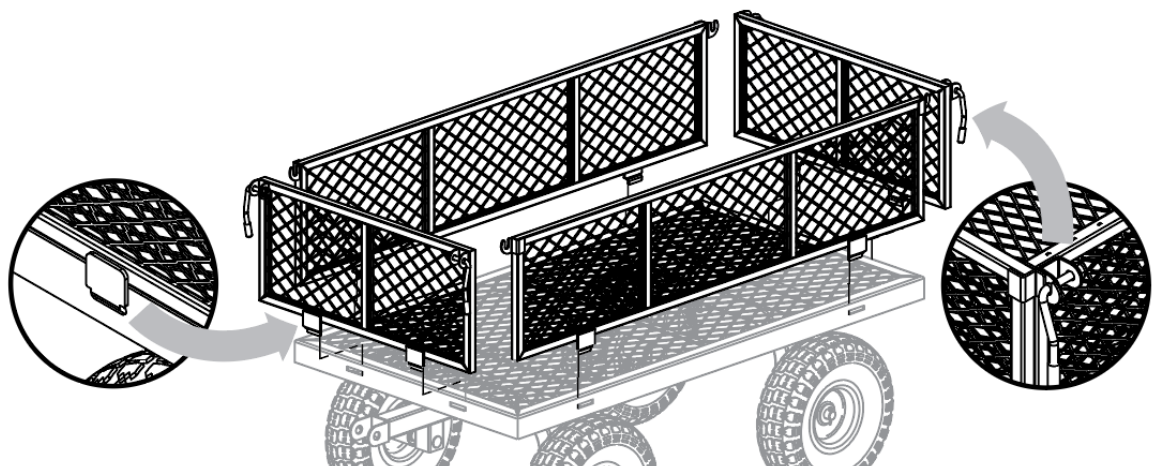
STEP 4

Turn the cart over. Slide the handle cap to the handle. Attach the handle to the yoke. Tighten the bolt securely.



STEP 5

Attach the front, rear, left, and right panels.

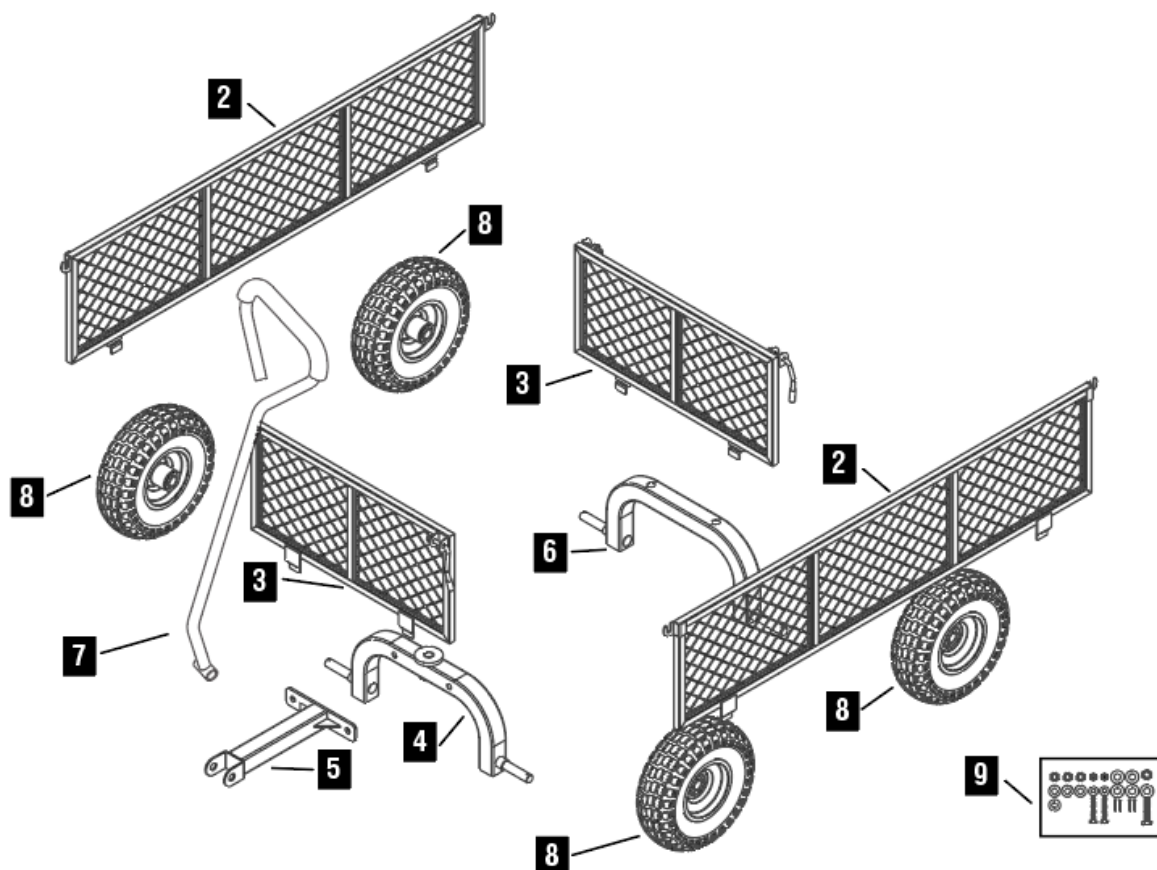

This limited warranty is not transferable.
