
IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS


- READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USE. If you do not understand these instructions, need clarification or further explanation, please call our toll free answer line for assistance at 1-800-304-1316 Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. CST.
- 2. Do not load wagon with more than 2000 lbs. (908 kg)
- 3. Do not allow children to use the wagon unsupervised. This wagon is not a toy.
- 4. Always distribute payload evenly over surface of bed.
- 5. Do not load any items on top of the fence. Lower fence when objects are to be loaded onto the wagon.
- 6. If any parts become damaged, broken or misplaced, do not use the wagon until replacement parts can be obtained.
- 7. Do not operate or use on objects that can cause damage to the pneumatic tires or tubes. **Do not inflate tires more than 35 psi.**
- 8. SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.





Tools required for assembly: Metric Socket Set, Wrenches and pliers.










To make the next steps less difficult, it is again recommended that the unit be turned over.

ASSEMBLY HARDWARE

- Bolts 10 x 20mm (20) 16 for connector brackets, 4 pre-assembled to angled support brackets
- **Bolts 10 x 35mm** (4) for straight support brackets
- Bolts 10 x 60mm (8) for straight and angled support brackets
- 18 Bolts 8 x 20mm (2) for side panel brackets
- Bolts 10 x 50mm (8) for installing tube connectors to front and rear axle frame
- Bolts 12 x 60mm (1) for installing pull handle
- Bolts 12 x 80mm (1) pre-assembled to front axle assembly
- **22** Lock Nuts 10mm (40)
- Lock Nuts 8mm (6) 4 pre-assembled lock handles, 2 for side panel brackets
- Lock Nuts 12mm (2) 1 for installing tractor pull handle. 1 pre-assembled to front axle assembly
- Washers 8mm (6) 2 for side panel brackets, 4 pre-assembled to lock handles
- **26** Washers 10mm (40)
- Washers 12mm (2) 1 for installing pull handle, 1 pre-assembled to front axle assembly
- Washers 20mm (6) 4 used on wheels, 2 pre-assembled to front axles
- 29 Pins 80mm (12) for attaching side panels to base panels
- **Pins 100mm** (2) for attaching side panels to side panel brackets
- **31 Clips** (14) for use with 80mm & 100mm pins
- 32 Small Cotter Pins (2) pre-assembled on front axle assembly
- 33 Large Cotter Pins (6) 4 for retaining wheels, 2 pre-assembled to front axle assembly
- **Small Clevis Pins** (2) pre-assembled on front axle assembly
- **35** Large Clevis Pin − (1) pre-assembled on tractor pull handle
- 36 Clevis Clip (1) pre-assembled on tractor pull handle
- 37 Lock Handles 8mm (4) pre-assembled on front and rear panels
